- 10- The Writing Center is located in APSC 301 and open Mon - Thurs 10am, Fri 10am-2pm, and have night hours available at Hamersley Library and Ackerman Hall.

10 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE ACADEMIC ADVISING AND LEARNING CENTER

- 1- Academic Advising is a key tool to help you get through college.
- 2- Advising holds are placed the 2nd week of every term.
- 3- Contact your advisor or Academic Advising to plan your education.
- 4- Know the track with your LACC requirements.
- 5- Meet face with your LACC requirements explore your interests.
- 6- Register online. Make a plan for the classes you want to take.
- 7- Consultation of graduation requirements and the responsibility of the student.
- 8- Know your Major and Minor, 62 of 100 credits must be upper division.
- 9- Calculate credits for your degree and complete a degree plan.
- 10- Apply for graduation 2 terms ahead of your graduation.
